- End of year awards June 5th@ 10 a.m. for all 9-11th grade students. (Honor Roll awards will be given in the Fall.
- BPS Science/Health Fair went amazing. BES and Napi students joined us for parts of the day and HS and MS students did an amazing job presenting to them. Students were engaged and excited about science.
- BHS 8th grade Parent meeting we had 29 parents join us on 5/12/25. We invited Cutswood, De La Salle and East Glacier parents to complete student registration so guidance counselors can start Fall schedules.
- BHS and BHA have been meeting and creating a plan of how to work together. Both campuses have worked with instructional coaches on Master Schedules and how we can continue the heavy metal symposium class but also offer some

credit recovery ELA classes in the afternoon without having to transfer our students to BHA.

- Tammy Hall Reagan will loop up with Juniors to Senior Advisor and Sienna Speicher will move back down to Freshman.
- Summer School has been discussed with all 9-11th students and guidance counselors are working hard to get students to enroll. All Guidance Counselors are creating a credit recovery document to help Summer School know what students need to work on and will create a feedback system so all recovered credits will be updated in infinite campus in the fall.
- All credit recovery next year 25/26 school year will be held during Night School. We will not offer Credit Recovery during the day with edgenuity. We will offer the classes with BHA staff but that is only for ELA full credit recovery.
- Plan is in place to ensure all incoming senior students have new state graduation requirements. ($\frac{1}{2}$ credit Civic/Government and $\frac{1}{2}$ financial literacy)
- BHS will have a new head secretary, assistant secretary, attendance clerk. We are interviewing this week and next week.
