#### Memorandum of Agreement with Robstown ISD September 01, 2023 through August 31, 2024

This Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between the **Education Service Center Region 12** ("ESC Region 12") and **Robstown ISD**. The purpose of this Agreement is to authorize ESC Region 12 to provide Support and/or training services to the staff of **Robstown ISD** for the LEA's Skyward Student Information System (SIS) software.

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Participating LEA is authorized by the Texas Education Code and the Texas Interlocal Cooperation Act (Chapter 791, Title 7, Government Code), to enter into agreements with Education Service Centers (ESC's); and,

WHEREAS, the Participating LEA desires to purchase certain Support Services; and,

WHEREAS, Texas Education Code 8.002 permits Regional Education Service Centers, at the discretion of the Commissioner of Education, to provide services to assist school districts in increasing efficiency and effectiveness of school operations (TEC 8.002). Authority for such services is granted under Texas Government Code §791.001 *et seq.*, as amended.

THEREFORE, now be it agreed that the undersigned Participating LEA, in return for payment of the consideration stated below, and subject to all terms of this Agreement, does hereby agree to the following terms, conditions, and general provisions.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Term of the Agreement
   The term of this Agreement shall be from September 01, 2023 through August 31, 2024.
- 2. Education Service Center Region 12 Responsibilities
  - ESC Region 12 will provide Skyward Student Information System software training and support, which includes providing training workshops, refresher trainings, etc. either onsite at the ESC Region 12 primary location in Waco, TX, remote (i.e., Zoom, WebExEx, etc) means, or Onsite at Robstown ISD.
  - ESC Region 12 will provide Robstown ISD the phone numbers and email addresses of ESC Region 12's support personnel for the purpose of direct support.

  - This Agreement stands alone, and is not intended to change, alter, or replace any existing or future contracts or agreements
  - Support shall be limited to the availability of the ESC Region 12's Skyward Student Software Support staff during normal working hours and calendar of ESC Region 12
  - ESC Region 12 may rotate or substitute support staff as needed
  - ESC Region 12 shall not be held responsible for the outcome or negative consequences of PEIMS, TSDS, or Federal Office of Civil Rights reporting, or any other issues related to, or including, desk-top audits, PBMAS Monitoring, Accountability Ratings, repayments, missed deadlines, issues with special programs/populations, or reduction in funding due to data and/or reporting issues
  - This Agreement is made only between ESC Region 12 and Robstown ISD, and is not part of any other contractual agreement involving Robstown ISD's primary (home), Education Service Center or Skyward, Inc.
- 4. Education Service Center Region 12's Skyward Support Package establishes a relationship with Robstown ISD, and includes membership in ESC Region 12's Skyward Student Cooperative (Coop). This Co-op provides:
  - a) Direct phone and email support, where designated District staff may call or email ESC Region 12's support staff for questions regarding the LEA's Skyward Student Information software;
  - b) Application-specific, follow-up webinars designed to provide more in-depth knowledge to the TSDS/PEIMS trainings as applicable to the Skyward Student Information System;
  - c) As an added value, TSDS/PEIMS Support and Training from ESC Region 12's PEIMS Support Staff, in which participants from Robstown ISD will be entitled to attend, at no additional cost, any TSDS/PEIMS Training sessions and Workshops held at ESC Region 12's primary location in Waco, Texas, or to join remotely when such workshops are offered through Zoom, WebEx, or other online sources. [Note: Pre-registration for all TSDS/PEIMS workshops and training sessions will be required in ESC Region 12's ESC Works]; and,
