 - ▶ Counselor collaboration with other classes.




Standard 6—Systemic Approach to Dropout Prevention with Social/Emotional Supports

- ▶ Responsive Services
- ▶ Tiered Systemic Approach in each school
- ▶ Prevention
 - ▶ Community Matters Conference
 - ▶ Hope Squads
 - ▶ Guest Speakers
- ▶ Intervention
 - ▶ Social/Emotional supports
 - ▶ Determined responsibilities of school counselors vs. responsibilities of School Psychologist, Social Worker, Social Emotional Specialists, and outside sources.



Standard 7—Alignment
