**TITLE:** Part-Time Summer Groundskeeper

## QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Ability to operate mowing and trimming equipment (training provided if needed)
- Willingness to work outdoors in various weather conditions
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds and perform physical labor
- Reliable, punctual, and able to work independently or as part of a team
- Previous groundskeeping or maintenance experience is a plus but not required

## **BASIC FUNCTION**

The Part-Time Summer Groundskeeper is responsible for assisting with the maintenance and upkeep of district grounds during the summer months. This position plays a key role in maintaining clean, safe, and attractive outdoor areas across school district properties.

#### PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Mow grass on school district grounds using riding and push mowers
- Perform string trimming and edging along sidewalks, fences, and landscaping features
- Assist with general grounds cleanup, including removing debris, trash, and fallen branches
- Maintain mulch and flower bed areas
- Support basic maintenance tasks as assigned
- Operate and maintain landscaping equipment in a safe and responsible manner
- Report any maintenance or safety issues to the supervisor promptly
- Follow all district safety procedures and guidelines

#### TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT

- Employment Period: Summer months (June–August)
- Work Schedule: Part-time, flexible daytime hours (as determined by supervisor)
- Compensation: Hourly wage; rate determined by the district
- The employee shall remain free of any alcohol or illegal substances in the workplace in conjunction with district policy.

## **EVALUATION**

Performance of employment responsibilities will be evaluated annually in accordance with the provision of Board of Education policy on evaluation of administrative personnel.
