

**RESOLUTION TO JOIN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
KNOWN AS THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM (TIPS)
PURCHASING COOPERATIVE**

WHEREAS, the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act provides that any public authority which has the power to tax, or any other public entity created by statute, may purchase personal property, supplies and services jointly with one or more other governmental units (30 ILCS 525/1, and 30 ILCS 525/2(a))

WHEREAS, the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act further provides that “Under any agreement of governmental units that desire to make joint purchases pursuant to subsection (a) of Section 2, one of the governmental units shall conduct the competitive procurement process.”

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Bloomingdale SD13 (the “School District”), DuPage County, Illinois has determined that it is in the best interest of the School District to join the agreement of governmental units known as The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) purchasing cooperative.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Education of Bloomingdale SD13, DuPage County, Illinois, resolves that:

Section 1. The Board hereby finds that the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true, and correct and does hereby incorporate them into this Resolution by reference.

Section 2. The Superintendent or her designee is hereby directed to execute such documents and take such actions as are necessary to join The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) purchasing cooperative.

Section 4. All other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and are repealed, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
