

Services provided by Adult Education and Literacy Program

- Provide services to Adult Learners to become literate and obtain the knowledge and skills necessary for employment and economic self-sufficiency, attain a high school equivalency or secondary school diploma, participate in postsecondary education and training through Workforce Training programs and enter or advance in employment in in-demand occupations that lead to economic self-sufficiency.
- Assist Adults who are English Language Learners to improve their reading, writing, speaking, and comprehension skills in English, acquire an understanding of the American system of government and the responsibilities of citizenship, participate in postsecondary education and training through Workforce Training programs and prepare them for unsubsidized employment in In-demand occupations that lead to economic self-sufficiency.
- Assist adults who are parents or family members to obtain the education and skills that are necessary to becoming full partners in the educational development of their children.
