10 Days



DAY 1-2 FLY TO ENGLAND.

Board an overnight flight to London. Welcome to the capital city of England! Begin your exploration with your NETC Tour Director.

DAY 3 LONDON.

A local guide brings you to the city's highlights. View Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, St. Paul's Cathedral, Trafalgar Square with Nelson's Column, and lively Piccadilly Circus. End your tour at the Changing of the Guard (seasonal).

DAY 4 EUROSTAR-PARIS.

Take the Eurostar through the Channel Tunnel to Paris. Your local guide gives you an up-close view of the Arc de Triomphe, the sweeping Champs-Élysées, Napoleon's gold-domed Les Invalides, and the Gothic splendor of Notre Dame Cathedral.

DAY 5 LOUVRE.

Visit the Louvre to see Da Vinci's Mona Lisa and marvel at the Venus de Milo. Create your own masterpiece in Cover the Canvas. This evening enjoy a walking tour of Sacre Coeur and the artist's quarter of Montmartre, recognizable in many of Toulouse-Lautrec's posters.

DAY 6 VERSAILLES.

Picture the flow of royalty through the vast grounds and gardens of the Palace of Versailles. A tour brings you to the Hall of Mirrors, the royal chapel and the gardens. Help your group Seize the Château! Board an overnight train to Italy.

DAY 7 FLORENCE-TUSCANY.

A local guide introduces "the Cradle of the Renaissance": see the Duomo, Ghiberti's Baptistry doors, the tiny shops on the Ponte Vecchio, and the Church of Santa Croce. Visit the Accademia to see Michelangelo's David.

DAY 8 ROME.

Journey to the land of Romulus and Remus with a local guide. Once in Rome, follow in the footsteps of ancient Romans as they cheered gladiators in the Colosseum, listened to philosophers at the Roman Forum, and walked proudly under the Arch of Constantine. Opt to train as one of Caesar's Gladiators.

DAY 9 VATICAN.

This morning visit the Vatican with a local guide and discover with your own eyes the artistic legacy of Catholicism in the lavish decorations of the Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica. This afternoon, stroll through the Piazza Navona and visit the Spanish Steps and the Trevi Fountain, still fed by water from a first-century Roman aqueduct.

DAY 10 **JOURNEY HOME TO UNITED STATES,** or add **extra days in Rome.**
