## Minidoka County School District Food service Report November 2016

## Claims

Our total reimbursement for the month of November is \$182,211.38 compared to \$174,755.57 for November 2015. We had 18 days in 2016 compared to 19 days in 2015. We had an average of 2,246 for breakfast this year and 2,100 for 2015. We had an increase of 146 breakfasts served. Our lunch numbers are as follows 2,762 for this year and 2,538 for 2015. We increase our lunch number by 224 this year so far.

## Projects

- We are looking to hire a part time employee at Minico to help with the cafeteria tables and to help with serving.
- We hope to be able to start demolition of the in the east side of our warehouse so that we can expand our dry storage and our freezer space.
- We have added an electronic monitoring system on our walk-in freezers and cooler at our warehouse. We set a low temperature limit and a high temperature limit and if one of the walk-ins goes beyond those limits then we get a text message letting us know that we may have a problem. This should save us from having a problem over the weekend or during holidays and not knowing about it.
