Overview of Turnaround Plan

Comprehensive Needs Assessment

- Root Cause Analysis:
 - Lack of strong instructional leadership
 - Low expectations for student outcomes
 - Inconsistent implementation and monitoring of essential systems and structures intended to support high-quality instruction



Turnaround Strategy #1

Foundational Leadership Transition

- Partnering with National Institute for Excellence in Teaching (NIET)
 - Instructional leaders will provide job-embedded professional learning, model effective instructional practices, and deliver real-time coaching to elevate Tier I instruction across all classrooms.



Turnaround Strategy #2

Alignment of Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment Practices

- Access to rigorous, TEKS-aligned instructional materials that support high academic achievement.
- Implementation of balanced assessment and data informed instruction.



Ongoing Monitoring and Support

Sustained and measurable implementation:

- Training for HQIM
- Lesson Internalization
- Weekly classroom walkthroughs and coaching cycles
- Baseline Data
- Utilizing data to progress monitor



Input Solicited

Feedback from Staff and Parents

- Feedback provided from staff:
 - Principals and instructional coaches set the tone and expectations for not only staff but students and parents.
 - Better communication between administration and teachers. Clear expectations and standards for teachers, as well as students by administrators. Holding teachers accountable to meet the standards.
- Feedback provided from parents:
 - Identifying barriers to learning, make a plan to help students and provide teachers with the proper training.
 - Setting goals for students as well as for the teachers.

- Teacher feedback loops embedded in cluster meetings
