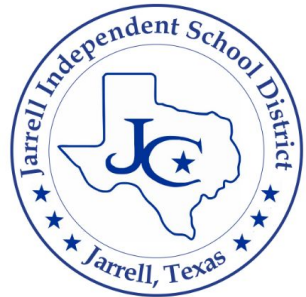

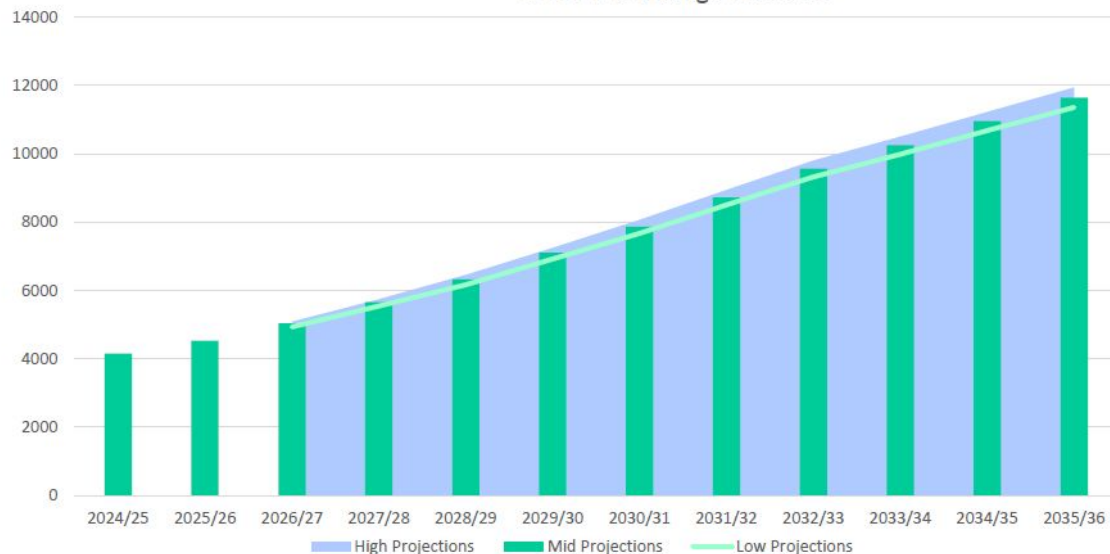

Low Range Projections

- Slow down in Housing Starts & Closings
- Increases in Homeschooling & Private School Enrollment
- Lower Kindergarten & Early Elementary Grade Enrollment
- School of Choice options lower overall housing yields

Mid-Range Projections

- Economic Conditions remain stable
- Continued population growth & Housing Activity
- Minimal Impact from trends in Homeschooling & Private School Enrollment
- Maintaining current housing yields
- Current Transfer patterns remain

High Range Projections

- Future Interest Rate Cuts & Favorable Mortgage Rates
- Surge in Housing Starts & Closings
- Programs and Marketing Efforts increase Enrollment through Transfer Students
- Slight increases in housing yields



Key Takeaways

District Information -



The District has seen enrollment rise this new 2025-26 school year by **375 students**, and over 1,500 students over the last five years

Housing Market Conditions -



JISD is currently falling behind 2024 totals in both annual new home starts and closings, due to the market tempering so far this year. Annual start rate for new homes is 917.

Housing Activity & Future Developments -



The district currently has approximately **480 homes in active inventory**, roughly 2,800 lots available to build on, and roughly 15,000 planned in the future.

Enrollment Forecast -



JISD Enrollment is forecasted to reach over 7,872 students by the 2030/31 school year, and with additional housing growth enrollment is anticipated to surpass 11,650 students by the 2035/36 school year.
