### **2007-2008 Board Goals**

The following represents the work of the Beeville ISD Board of Trustees on June 11, 2007, to provide the Board and Superintendent of Schools direction and priorities for the 2007-2008 school year. The process for determining goals included a facilitator from the Education Service Center, Region II. The Superintendent will attempt to address all of the goals, report progress intermittently, and provide a summary at the time of the annual evaluation.

The goals for 2007-2008 are to:

1. Review the plan and documentation/results of retaining students in school and results of follow up after high school (plan includes objectives, actions, etc.)
2. Continue to educate staff on what it means to be a professional
3. Achieve academic excellence as measures by:
  - State accountability (recognized or above)
  - Federal accountability
  - AP scores
  - Number of students in dual credit courses
  - Number of students participating in UIL
  - SAT/ACT scores
  - Communicating academic excellence-study best practices
4. Continue to implement the plan for parent and community support for education
5. Continue to implement the plan for increased efficiency of operations
