The district is requesting approval to order 5 buses in advance of the adoption of the fiscal year 2026 capital budget. Supply chain and manufacturing delays continue to impact the commercial and automotive industry. The intent of this advance order is to ensure the arrival of these necessary fleet enhancements as close to the start of the school year as possible. It is best practice to start the school year with our bus fleet intact for the following reasons:

- 1. Students will have a consistent bus number the entire year.
- 2. Bus drivers will practice routes and train on a consistent vehicle.
- 3. Mechanic time is not wasted prepping older buses that will be replaced in a few months.

Current fleet statistics:

- 1. 101 buses, 6 student transportation vans and 1 mobile classroom bus in the fleet.
- 2. With this purchase, 5 regular education buses will be replaced due to high mileage and increasing maintenance costs.

Vehicle purchases will be made from the state contract, so bidding is not required. The estimated cost of the vehicles is \$770,000.00 and funding for all vehicles will be provided through a combination of the annual operating capital budget and capital project levy.
