*To promote and advocate for student achievement, at the local, regional, State and National level, serving as a conduit both to and from the OSBA to the member Districts within the Gorge Region.*

*The ability to unite and bring people together to benefit student achievement; recently, my local District was able to apply for and receive an ODE OSCIM Grant, increase our proposed bond amount (\$1.06 per thousand to \$1.45 per thousand) and successfully pass a General Obligation bond with almost 77% passage rating. In addition, our District recently transitioned from a part time Superintendent to a Full Time Superintendent, which required the Board to evaluate the long term objectives of the District, integrate the objectives and goals into a job description, and proceed through a deliberate and thoughtful selection and hiring process to ensure selection of the right candidate.*

*Addressing the K-20 Education funding issue plaguing our State, and continuing the positive momentum under Betsy's tenure with the new Executive Director hire.*

5. What do you see as the two most challenging issues faced by your region?

*Rural Oregon faces several challenges – most notably, funding issues including addressing the PERS dilemma, enrollment fluctuations, and facilities, and ensuring that local Districts are able to retain local control in regards to State and National Education policies.*

*Through active participation in OSBA State and Regional Events, active outreach via the OSBA List Serve, and ensuring I am available as needed for our local and regional Districts to connect with, via email and phone or in person.*
