## Phi Theta Kappa Awards April 28, 2020

Collin College's Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Chapter continued its tradition of excellence and winning awards at the PTK Regional Conference on March 5-7 (physically held in Abilene) and at the PTK International Conference, Catalyst, on April 16-17 (conducted virtually this year).

Notably, Collin's Alpha Mu Tau Chapter is again ranked as a **Five Star Chapter**. The chapter also won first place in the regional community service award category for its **CougarThon Children's Miracle Network Dance Marathon** and was awarded the **2020 Beta Alpha Continued Excellence Award** at the Catalyst International Conference.
