

## LSAC Meeting Minutes 3/5/25

I. Call to order: Meeting called to order at 3:10 pm

II. Roll Call of LSAC Members: Toni, Jaclyn, Maxine, Tisha, and Breanna

III. Introduction of Visitors: Josh, JW, Lurn, Aaron, Adam, Andrew, Micarlo, John III and Clarise

VI. Student Reports (Designated Student Govt): Micarlo proposes and trip to Hawaii with student government funds. But per LSPD they must present to the LSAC, then fill out a form for LPSD. Toni suggests buying tickets on Alaska airlines, and starting their trip from King Salmon, Alaska airlines will allow multiple destinations and an overnight in Anchorage all under one booking. J.W. has the form and will fill it out the students on Monday to submit it, as there is a minimum of 60 days prior to the trip for LPSD to approve it. There will be 2 adults and 5 students going. Max suggests doing a community service while there in Maui. Jw says they have about 10,000 for a budget. Student store orders have been made, and kids' items have started arriving. They have some set prices already and their goal is to not have any items left over when school is over. They will also have extra Meshik hoodies to sell at carnival. Students are also planning a movie night on Saturday.
