## BACKGROUND/CONSIDERATIONS:

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) licensed school districts for the use of channels within a specific frequency spectrum in 1963. The FCC provided this Educational Broadband Service (EBS) spectrum to promote the delivery of educational content. FSPS is currently one of only two educational institutions in Arkansas with full ownership of its licensed channels.

There is currently a market seeking to purchase the channels within this frequency spectrum. In December of 2020, the district advertised a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) in order to a secure a broker/agent to provide potential buyers of these channels to the district.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

If the Board agrees, the motion would read: *move to* approve the district to partner with Select Spectrum in order to promote the sale of the district's channels within the EBS frequency spectrum.
