**1. Provide a DETAILED RATIONALE explaining how the waiver will enhance student learning opportunities, promote innovation, or increase equitable access to effective teachers. Include information about the problem or obstacle; if any, the waiver will help the district overcome.**

The member school districts of the Northeast Arkansas Education Service Cooperative are collectively and separately requesting a waiver from A.C.A. 6-10-106, which establishes the first allowable day of class as the Monday of the week that contains August 19. For the 2024-2025 school year, it will be Monday, August 19, 2024.

We respectfully request a waiver to allow the Lawrence County School District to set their start date “no earlier” than August 12 for each of the next five school years.

The advantages of the early start option include the following:

1. It gives us a greater chance of having more instructional time before state testing, even in years when we miss a significant number of days due to inclement weather.
2. It allows us to begin in mid-August when students and staff are eager to return to the new year and complete the year by the end of May before many of the summer activities begin in early June.
3. It provides a greater balance between the number of days in the first and second semesters of the school year.

**2. Provide a detailed explanation of how the services being waived will be provided for students.**

The requested waiver will not impact the calendar length chosen by the Lawrence County School District. It will only provide the flexibility to begin the school year earlier, providing the above advantages to students, staff, and parents. The services provided to our students will be the same as those supplied without waiver approval regarding days and/or hours of instruction.

**3. Provide a detailed explanation of how the district will monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the waiver.**

The district will monitor the following items: 1) # of instructional days or hours gained in advance of state testing by starting earlier, 2) student and staff attendance on those dates, and 3) state test results to try and determine what correlation exists between achievement results and instruction time before testing.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF LAWRENCE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT TO REQUEST A WAIVER

WHEREAS, the LAWRENCE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT Board of Directors is committed to providing a high-quality education to all students within the district;

WHEREAS, certain circumstances or regulations may require the district to seek waivers to better address the unique needs or challenges faced by the district;

WHEREAS, Arkansas law, A.C.A 6-10-106, provides for the school year to begin no earlier than the Monday of the week containing August 19; and

WHEREAS, under this law, A.C.A 6-10-106, the start of school varies from year to year, beginning some years as early as August 14, or as late as August 20; and

WHEREAS a late start to the school year creates unbalanced semesters, reduces the preparation time for state testing, and limits flexibility in scheduling inclement weather make-up days;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of LAWRENCE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT hereby authorizes the district administration to formally request a waiver allowing the district's first day of class to be "no earlier than August 12";

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent or designee is authorized to take all necessary steps and actions to submit the waiver request, including providing any additional information or documentation required by the relevant authorities;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors expresses its support for the waiver request and acknowledges the importance of flexibility in addressing the unique needs and circumstances of the district.


This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

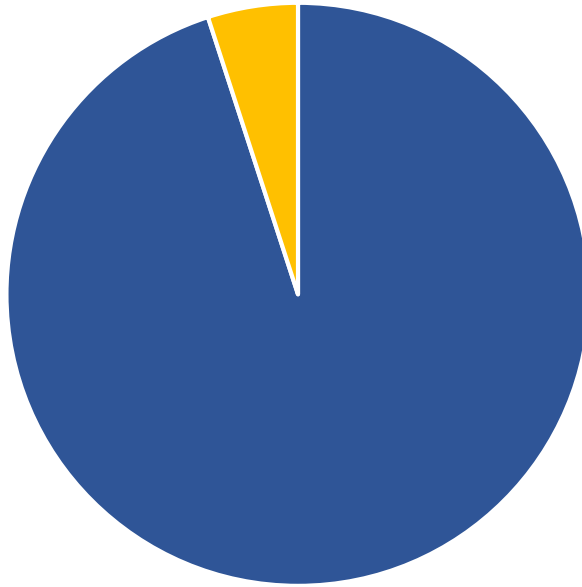

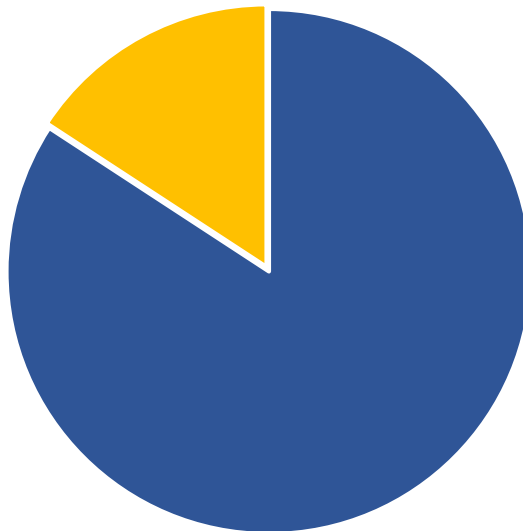
Would you support the district's efforts in seeking a waiver to start school as soon as August 12, 2024, in place of the required August 19, 2024, start date?
