Classroom Teachers


- Students receive extra help from their teacher

- Teacher listens to individual students read (conferring)
- Small group math/reading for higher levels
- Enrichment activities (science or social studies)
- Work on homework

Choice in our Instruction

At Wildwood, over the last few years, we have incorporated more <u>choice</u> and <u>movement</u> into our instruction:

- Choose their own personal library of books to read based on their interests and reading level
- Choose where to sit or stand during a lesson
- Choose to work with a partner or by themselves on some assignments.
- Choose how to solve a math problem (math talks)
- Choose how to demonstrate their learning
- Choose how to fix a problem they are having with another person (Restorative Practices)
