



CCC Quality Education & Job Training


CCC provides affordable career technical programs, college transfer degrees and basic skills education, along with workforce and business services, job training and community education classes.

Molalla & CCC

- * A total of 17% of Molalla citizens attended Clackamas Community College last academic year (2012-13)
- 29% of the 2012 Molalla High School graduating class enrolled at Clackamas Community College
- ★ 10 Molalla businesses utilized the services of the Small Business Development Center in 2013

Partnership with Molalla HS

- MHS students earned 1,326 total credits at CCC in 2012-13
- Families saved \$104,754 total through the High School's partnership with CCC

Community, Students and Employers Want


- Degrees and certificates that lead to careers and family-wage jobs

- Update and modernize equipment, labs and facilities so students are trained to industry standards






CCC Responds (cont.):

- Continue average annual bond rate of \$0.19
 per \$1,000 of assessed property value
- Leverage \$16 million in state match
- Invest \$40,000 in each of our school districts to strengthen equipment or technology to support learning partnerships
- Construct an industrial technical learning center
- Expand and modernize equipment and facilities for training in high-demand careers
- Improve buildings throughout the district
- Replace 61-year-old building at the Harmony Community Campus with an updated workforce development and training facility
