

Assessment

- Primary focus of work is on various preparatory tasks for the ACT, WorkKeys, Badger Exam, DLM, and NAEP. These tasks include student enrollment data uploads, student rosters, administration requirements, training details, webinars, online recordings, etc.
- Teachers of grade levels administering the Badger Exam are working with students to assist them in gaining familiarity with question format requirements and technology access skills.

Curriculum
