7. **Superintendent Report**
  - A. **Bond Election/Next Steps**

As a result of the November 2024 bond unsuccessfully passing, possibly due to ballot language, Superintendent Wes Corzine presented various options for the board to consider to add additional classrooms and a junior high science lab. One option presented was a portable building designed by Ramtech Building Systems. This building could support a science lab and a second classroom. Another option would be to relocate some staff in the main building to other rooms.

- B. **Second 6 weeks Budget Report**

The 2024-2025 budget is on trend as expected. The special education and Career and Technical Education full-time equivalents increased for the six weeks. The WADA for the six weeks was lower than budgeted due to illness.
