 - Students are honing their pantomime skills, mastering facial expressions, and having a blast with movement. They're using body language and characterizations to create vivid stage pictures.

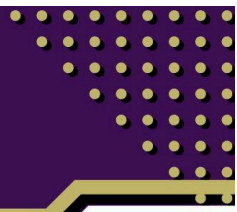
Music
