Subject: Termination of Grant Award 1628

Dear Mr. Thayer,

This memorandum serves as formal notice of the termination of Grant Award 1628 titled *Craig High School Biomass Project*, awarded to Alaska Energy Authority on November 1, 2020, pursuant to 2 CFR 200.340 (a)(4). In accordance with the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (2 CFR 200), specifically §200.340(a)(4), a Federal award may be terminated in whole or in part if “the Federal awarding agency ... determines that the award no longer effectuates the program goals or agency priorities.”

After a recent review of our current strategic direction and funding priorities, it has been determined that the aforementioned project no longer aligns with the agency’s programmatic goals and priorities, including those shaped by current Executive Orders and associated recommendations. As a result, the decision has been made to terminate this award effective May 13, 2025.

Your organization is entitled to reimbursement for activities up to the termination date and you should file a final reimbursement request as soon as possible.

Please note the following requirements as part of this termination process:

1. **Final Financial and Performance Reports** must be submitted no later than 90 days.
2. **Disposition of Unused Funds and Property:** Any unspent funds must be returned, and all property acquired under the award must be handled in accordance with 2 CFR 200.313-200.315.
3. **Audit and Record Retention:** All records related to the award must be retained and remain available for audit in accordance with 2 CFR 200.334.
