### TIA Update

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#### **Board Goal:**

#### **Purpose of Report**

- The purpose of this workshop is to update the Board regarding the planning progress of the upcoming 2019 TIA (Technology In Action) conference hosted by Denton ISD

#### **Objectives**

- To provide Denton ISD staff with quality professional development that focuses on integrating technology into the learning environment so that our students are ready for 21<sup>st</sup> century success
- To provide our community (residents, business professionals, community members, etc...) with quality professional development that focuses on technology, social media, and productivity tools
- To provide outside-of-district educators with a low cost, quality professional development opportunity that features many of the large conference amenities (vendors, hands on workshops, certifications, etc...)
- To showcase Denton ISD as a leader of learning and promote the positive initiatives happening within our district

#### **Operational Impact**

- TIA is currently a self-funded event (via participant registration, vendor sponsorships, and donations)
- District funds are not required to produce this event
- The conference is hosted in a Denton ISD facility (Braswell HS)
- This annual conference is held in mid to late July (this year, July 16 & 17)

#### **Results**

As a result of the TIA conference:

- Denton ISD teachers will be better equipped to effectively infuse technology into their learning environment
- Students will be better prepared for college and the 21<sup>st</sup> century workplace as their teachers are utilizing the strategies and techniques that TIA provides
