SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from HMI Services Inc in the amount of \$459,985.00 for the purchase of the technology infrastructure for the Cheek Middle School campus.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This equipment provides fiber engineering, materials, and installation for the campus.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

This fiber and installation will be purchased from HMI Services Inc through Denton ISD RFP #2006-06. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District’s CH(local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne by this project’s 2018 Bond Authorization budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to bring the new Cheek Middle School network infrastructure online for the 2023-2024 school year.
