DESCRIPTION:

As part of the district's ongoing commitment to health and safety, radon testing is conducted annually at one or more district sites in collaboration with our Health and Safety Consultant. The results of these tests are shared with the School Board in accordance with Minnesota Department of Health guidelines. To support healthy environments within our buildings, each district site undergoes testing every five years on a rotating schedule.

This year radon testing was conducted at the Montrose Early Education Center, Pride Transitions Building, Northwinds Elementary School and Tatanka Elementary STEM School.

The results of the testing indicate that radon levels were below the action levels set by the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and no mitigation efforts are required by the district.
