BACKGROUND:

National Center for Women & Information Technology (NCWIT) proudly announced the 2020 NCWIT Award for Aspirations in Computing (AiC) national recipients. Each year, U.S. high school female students in grades 9 through 12 are eligible to receive recognition for their aptitude and aspirations in technology and computing, as demonstrated by their computing experience, computing-related activities, leadership experience, tenacity in the face of barriers to access, and plans for post-secondary education.
