








Meal Participation

2025: Establishes product-based limits for breakfast cereals, yogurt, and flavored milk (NSLP and CACFP)

- Cereal <6g / dry oz (1 BG)
- Yogurt <8g / 4 oz (1 MMA)
- Flavored Milk <10g / 8oz (1 Cup)

2027: Establishes a weekly limit (<10% weekly calories from added sugars for both lunch and breakfast programs)
