B. Aledo ISD 2025 Committee Progress Report

C. Bell Helicopter Donations

On March 4th two helicopter fuselages were donated to Aledo ISD. The value of these properties is several hundred thousand dollars per unit. The airframes will be used as early as the 2015-16 school year as part of the new career tech program and Business and Industry Endorsement for upcoming graduates who may select that strand.

The donation to Aledo ISD is part of a seven ship donation to six school districts by Bell Helicopter and is done to further the work we, and other districts, have done in this strand.

The two "bodies" will be stored out of the elements until such time that the students need them.
