HISTORY: The Employee Handbook is reviewed and updated annually to ensure alignment with current district policies, state and federal laws, and the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) guidance. The 2025–2026 edition incorporates updates from the TASB Model Employee Handbook following the 88th Texas Legislative Session and revisions specific to San Elizario ISD policies and procedures.

RATIONALE: The Employee Handbook is a vital communication tool to ensure all employees know the district's expectations, policies, procedures, and resources. Annual updates are necessary to maintain compliance with changing legislation and district policy, promote transparency, and support employee understanding of their roles and responsibilities. Adopting the updated handbook supports a consistent and equitable working environment across all campuses and departments.
