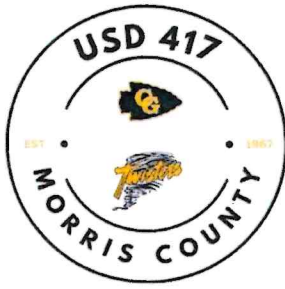

This topic was addressed during the Director of Teaching and Learning's presentation on Student Success.

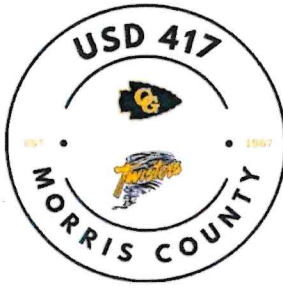

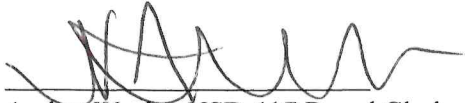

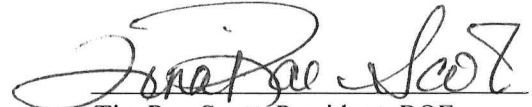
