Summary:	This item requests approval of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Denton ISD (Joe Dale Sparks) and the Juvenile Board of Denton County.
Background Information/ Previous Board Action:	The Board of Trustees for Denton ISD reviews and takes action on this agreement annually. The background information is that The Denton County Juvenile Detention Center (Facility), located within the District, provides residential services for school-aged children. Some Facility residents may qualify for special education and at-risk services as required by Federal and State statutes and regulations. The students residing at the Facility are placed in the Facility for the primary purpose of treatment and rehabilitation while in Detention awaiting their court appearance(s) or are residents of the post adjudication program.
