Summary:	Pursuant to Texas Education Code § 37.108, public school districts must conduct a comprehensive safety and security audit of all instructional and non-instructional facilities at least once every three years. The law requires districts to report the audit findings to their local Board of Trustees and to the Texas

School Safety Center (TxSSC) in the prescribed format. In accordance with state requirements, the district must retain a copy of the final audit report, and the audit survey must be signed by both the Board President and the Superintendent.

In compliance with state law, Grapevine-Colleyville Independent School District (GCISD) contracted with the Region 11 Education Service Center to conduct a thorough safety and security audit of all District facilities during the spring of 2026.

The finalized audit report has been received and presented to both the GCISD Safety and Security Committee and the Board of Trustees. To maintain campus security and protect sensitive operational protocols, the details of the audit report remain strictly confidential under Texas law.

Additionally, District staff completed the required TxSSC Safety and Security Audit Survey. Both the audit documentation and the completed survey will be formally submitted to the TxSSC prior to the state deadline of September 15, 2026.
