Background Information:

- The 4-H organization has been recognized by the Texas Education Agency as a legitimate school-related extracurricular organization. Tarrant County 4-H Organization is approved for recognition and eligible for extracurricular status consideration under Texas Administrative Code §76.1001, pertaining to extracurricular activities. The resolution naming 4-H as an extracurricular activity and an agreement to add Tarrant County staff members as adjunct faculty of Keller ISD require annual board approval.
- The combination of approvals allows the District to receive ADA for students by allowing students to participate in 4-H activities off-site and yet be counted “in attendance” for funding purposes when under the supervision of Tarrant County adjunct faculty or a Keller ISD staff member.

Administrative Considerations:

- Approval of resolution allows for voluntary student participation in programs conducted by the Tarrant County 4-H organization in recognition of the educational benefits arising from such participation and activities.
- Approval of resolution allows students who participate in off-campus activities with the 4-H organization and with an adjunct staff member to be considered “in attendance” for Keller ISD attendance accounting purposes.
