ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO SCHOOL

PURPOSE: To establish standard guidelines for student school assignment based on residential attendance zones within the Nye County School District, while providing criteria for approved out-of-zone placements, open enrollment under state law, and clarifying family transportation responsibilities.

RESPONSIBLE OFFICE: Superintendent/Designee & Site Administrators

Nye County School District (NCSD) students will be expected to attend the school which lies within the attendance zone area in which they reside, with the following exceptions:

1. The change involves an exceptional student or a hardship case, or if there are medical considerations.
2. The change appears to be in the best interests of the student and of the school.
3. The legal residence of a student changes from one attendance zone area to another during the school year and the parents/legal guardians wish the student to remain in his/her former school. Such permission will not extend beyond the current school year.
4. The student attains a placement outside their zone of attendance in accordance with Assembly Bill 533 (83rd Session 2025).

All students who, at their own preference, attend school outside their attendance zone area will be required to provide their own transportation.
