10. FOR THE GOOD OF THE ORDER

Mr. Micken, Food Service Director, introduced Boy Scout Troop 246 to the board. All students in the troop are Winston-Dillard students. The scouts were practicing lowering and raising the flag prior to the board meeting. Scout, Josiah Eveland shared with the board his Eagle Scout project. The project involves a former whale sculpture at Winchester Bay that was removed due to the decaying materials. He is working on raising funds so that a new one can be constructed out of concrete.

Mr. Rob Holveck, WMS Principal, shared that staff have really come together to work on the schedules to be prepared for the students and the new school year.

Mrs. Lisa Dickover, BES Principal, reported that summer school just wrapped up and they had a really great turnout. The teachers were very dedicated in the program and the session ended with a trip to Wildlife Safari. Mr. Welker helped with the organization and Bob Coburn did a great job with the transportation needs. She also shared that Mr. Micken did an awesome job with providing the meals. Mrs. Dickover also reported that the new entrance doors are almost complete. The wood chips donation through Roseburg Forest Products was divided among the three elementary schools. The maintenance staff did a great job at spreading the chips to get the playgrounds ready for the students.

Mrs. Emily Ledbetter, LES Principal said that their summer school program went well. They had about 30 students participate. She said each week had a different theme, and her opinion was that this helped with student attendance and engagement in the program. Mrs. Ledbetter also shared the school will be doing a "Meet the Teacher" event on the 20th. Their TAPS group will be providing all the school supplies for the students again this year. Open house is planned for 27th which will be the first full day of school for the students.

Mr. Craig Anderson, DHS Principal, shared that it was refreshing to have that summer break. He shared that there was a really big turnout of students who came to get their sports physicals completed. There is also quite a few sports camps that students are participating in this week. Mr. Dave Welker, Director of Instructional Services, shared that the encounters at Wildlife Safari during the summer school session is made available through a three-year grant. He said that Brockway and McGovern enjoyed encounters with the elephants and McGovern and Winston Middle School had their encounter with the lions. Students also had a chance to get up close with one of the safari's cheetahs. The students really seemed to enjoy their experience. Mr. Kevin Wilson, Superintendent, shared that all staff will be welcomed back with breakfast on their first day back on the 17th and it will be held in the new gym at DHS.
