Re: Approval of practice gym wood floor replacement at Coppell High School

The 2023 Bond election, Proposition A, includes funding for gymnasium wood flooring replacements at Coppell High School. The current small practice gym at Coppell High School has sustained previous water damage and has begun to buckle. This creates a safety hazard for the teams practicing and playing games on the surface.

The District is in the process of soliciting pricing from multiple vendors that are available on existing purchasing cooperatives. In an effort to get this flooring replaced in time with minimal impact to the basketball season, we are recommending a not to exceed price of \$250,000 be authorized by the Board of Trustees for this work.

Following Board approval, all quotes will be received and evaluated to determine the best value to the District. Best value will be determined based not only on pricing, but also the vendor's timeline and previous proven experience with projects of similar scope. Once the best value has been determined, work will be scheduled with the anticipated completion by late October 2026.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approves a not to exceed expenditure of \$250,000 to replace the practice gym wood floor at Coppell High School with a vendor that is determined to be best value for this work once quotes are received.
