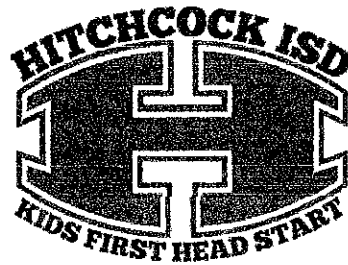

First day of school: August 11, 2026 - 138 enrolled; 131 attended.

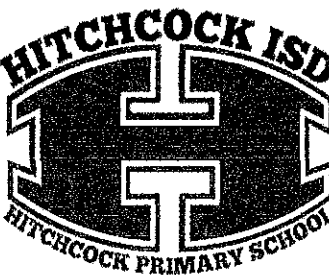
