TOPIC: ***Approval of Purchase of Bulk Salt**

RECOMMENDATION

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approves the purchase of 1,100 tons of bulk road salt from Detroit Salt Company, Detroit, Michigan, through the State of Michigan MiDEAL cooperative purchasing program, at a total cost of \$73,634.

RATIONALE

The purchase of bulk road salt will provide an adequate supply for winter weather operations during the 2026-2027 winter season. Procuring salt through a cooperative purchasing program ensures competitive pricing and cost efficiency while allowing the District to maintain an appropriate inventory for seasonal needs.

Maintaining safe walkways, parking lots, roadways, and building access points is critical to ensuring the safety of students, staff, families, and visitors. Securing an adequate supply in advance also supports operational continuity and timely snow and ice removal during winter weather events.
