

INTERROGATIONS AND QUESTIONS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

After students have been reminded of their right to remain silent by the police or other law enforcement officers, they may interrogate or question students in school buildings or on school grounds, in coordination with the School Resource Officer and with notification to the building principal, before conducting further investigation. The student's parent or guardian shall be notified of the police interview of their child as soon as possible, except in the case of allegations against the parent or guardian. The principal should work with the police officer to determine how notification to the parent or guardian is handled.
