SUBJECT: Discussion and Possible Action of the Optional Flexible School Day Program (OFSDP) Application for the 2026-2027 School Year and Program Presentation of The Opportunity Academy (TOA)

Agenda Summary:

The Optional Flexible School Day Program (OFSDP) allows Canutillo ISD to provide flexible hours and days of attendance for students who meet at least one of the requirements of the Texas Education Code §29.0822(a). The goal of the program is to improve graduation rates for students who are in danger of dropping out of school, have dropped out, or are behind in course credits needed to graduate on time. The Opportunity Academy (TOA) is the program that gives our students and student leavers the platform to stay in the Canutillo District and continue their education through a non-traditional setting designed to close missing credit gaps, support credit recovery, and guide non-traditional students toward high school graduation.

Benefits:

The program's overall effectiveness is highlighted by its strong completion and stable graduate output over time. Even with annual fluctuations in overall enrollment and Individual Graduation Committees (IGCs), graduate numbers have remained steady—consistently yielding between 17 and 26 total graduates (including summer completers) each year. For the 2025-2026 school year, TOA students completed 317 courses, and 921 courses in the past four years. TOA continues to focus on refining operational efficiencies, transforming staff collaboration, and maximizing educational resources to ensure every enrolled student achieves their graduation goals.
