Summary:	Resolution declaring approximately 0.469 acres (20,447 sq. ft.) of District-owned real property at the NW corner of Grackel Street and Roselawn Drive as surplus, and authorizing a Donation Deed conveying the property to the City of Denton.
Background Information/ Previous Board Action:	Denton I.S.D. owns a small tract of land adjacent to Denia Park that has been determined to be no longer suitable or needed for educational use. District staff recommend the Board declare the property surplus and authorize its donation to the City of Denton via Donation Deed for continued public use.
Potential Operational Impact:	None. The property is not utilized for District operations or educational programming.
Potential Financial Impact	None. The District waives any right to compensation for the property as part of the donation; there is no cost to the District associated with this conveyance.
