

# Federal Grant Programs and Purposes

## **Title I, Part A Improving Basic Programs**

Purpose: Provide all children with a significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education to close educational achievement gaps.

## **Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Part B Formula**

Purpose: Provide supplemental funds to support a free appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment for children with disabilities, ages three through twenty-one.

## **Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Part B Preschool**

Purpose: Provide supplemental funds to support a free appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment for children with disabilities, ages three through five.

## **Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Discretionary (Deaf)**

Purpose: Provide supplemental funds to support a free appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment for children with disabilities, ages three through twenty-one enrolled in a Regional Day School Program for the Deaf.

## **Perkins V: Strengthening CTE for 21<sup>st</sup> Century**

Purpose: Develop the academic, technical, and employability skills of secondary education students who elect to enroll in a CTE program.

## **Title II, Part A Support Effective Instruction**

Purpose: To support educators (teachers, principals, and other school leaders) in their work to improve the overall quality of instruction and ensure equity of educational opportunity for all students.

## **Title III, Part A English Language Acquisition, Language Enhancement, and Academic Achievement Act**

Purpose: Provide English language learners, including immigrant children and youth, the necessary support to attain English proficiency, develop high levels of academic attainment in English, and meet the same challenging State academic content and student academic achievement standards as all children are expected to meet.

## **Title IV, Part A Student Support and Academic Enrichment**

Purpose: Provide access to opportunities for a well-rounded education for all students, improve school conditions for student learning in order to create a safe and healthy school environment; and improve access to personalized learning experiences supported by technology and professional development for the effective use of technology.
