AGENDA ITEM:

Report Out of the Campus Facilities and Construction Committee and Consideration of Approval to Authorize the District President or His Designee to Negotiate and Execute a Memorandum of Agreement and Related Agreements with the University of North Texas for the Use and Development of Real Property in Collin County

DISCUSSION:

Collin College and the University of North Texas (UNT) have discussed a potential partnership involving the development and use of real property in Collin County to support educational programs and services that benefit students and the broader community.

The proposed arrangement would provide a framework for Collin College and UNT to coordinate the development, construction, and use of facilities located at the Frisco Campus on the third floor of the new Health Sciences Center. The memorandum of agreement would establish the general terms and responsibilities of each institution, including the College's responsibility for construction costs and UNT's responsibility for equipment necessary to support its programs, including the replacement and maintenance of such equipment.
