BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Type: Consent

The District has ten (12) school facilities and a District office that is currently equipped with

Openeye security cameras, Aiphone devices, and Aurora keyscan software are used to manage access control. The district is seeking contract renewal to maintain, clean, and troubleshoot this equipment. Gregory-Portland ISD has approximately 86 keyscan panels with 319 doors and their peripheral devices, 87 Wi-Fi gateways for the Wi-Fi locks, 581 Eplex locks, and 29 Aiphone devices. In addition, the District has 31 Open-eye NVRs and 901 Open-eye cameras.

An RFP was sent out last year and once the vendor was selected, the contract was board approved with the possibility of two voluntary one-year extensions.

RECOMMENDATION:

Administration recommends that the school board accept the one-year extension of services from Network Cabling Services based on the quality and efficiency of work.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The current contract with Network Cabling Services is set to total to \$182,959.00, invoiced at \$15,246.58 monthly.
