Background Information:

In accordance with Board Policy CDC (Local), the Board of Trustees must approve any bequest or gift of money or property if the value of the gift is \$20,000 or more. To be acceptable, a gift must have a purpose consistent with district goals and objectives.

Administrative Considerations:

- During the winter storm earlier this year, Freedom Elementary's library sustained water damage that impacted a large number of the books in the library's collection.
- Atmos expressed interest in donating \$25,000 to go toward restocking the FRES library.
- The donor understands that the donation will become the property of Keller ISD and will be under the authority of the superintendent in accordance with board policy and administrative rules and regulations.
