

Resolution of the Board to Set Tax Rate

DATE: August 31, 2026

On this date, we, the Board of Trustees of the Wylie Independent School District, hereby levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the tax year 2026 at a total tax rate of \$1.1171, to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collector as follows:

\$.6445 for the purpose of maintenance and operations, and

\$.4726 for the purpose of payment of principal and interest on debts.

Such taxes are to be assessed and collected by the tax officials designated by the District.
