- The chips from chip sealing have been cleaned up and fog sealing has been completed.
- The car port has been replaced/installed at the dog park.
- Jacob has been working on installing meters and we may add some more guys to helping him get that done. We are hoping to complete this project over the winter months.
- The buckthorn in the frisbee golf areas has been mowed vs putting the goats in there to make it more convenient to play frisbee golf.
- Our back bone yard area has been cleaned up with all scrap metal hauled in and piles of fill material have been cleaned up.
- The bleachers in Meadow Park North have been repaired.
- The path in Rolling Ridge has been completed. We are waiting for the material to dry out to place the dirt along the edges.
- We have been working on 2027 budget with Kelly.
- We have ripped out the bridge entrance in Florence Park. We will have whoever patches our watermain breaks place the asphalt for that entrance. Erosion and time have caused settling in this area.
