Re: Anatomage Table

Weber District CTE teaches a wide range of classes in healthcare from CNA to medical anatomy, medical terminology EMR, and physical therapy as well as other health science courses. Last year, in our CLNA (needs assessment) it indicated that the fastest growing and largest sector was in healthcare. That said, in order to give students experience that is foundational, build valuable skills preparing them for the world of work and to be Future Ready, we want to give students access to technology to grow those skills and point them to careers that are high-wage high-demand in Weber County. To do this, we want to purchase a product called the Anatomage table to be paid for by our Federal Perkins Grant the needed funding.

The total amount requested for purchase approval: The Anatomage Table is a life-sized, interactive digital anatomy table used for teaching anatomy, physiology, pathology, radiology, and surgical planning. Instead of using a traditional cadaver alone, it allows users to perform virtual dissections on highly detailed 3D models created from real human cadaver data. This can be used not only for humans but also animal cadavers in a range of courses. We have budgeted a total of \$93,225.00 to purchase 1 of these tables. They will be used in multiple classes from CNA to medical terminology, to EMR. None of this money will come from district CTE, instead it is funded from the Federal Perkins Grant written by WSD CTE.
