Subject: Professional Learning Plan 2026-2029

Background Information:

- The purpose of the District Professional Learning Plan is to support the growth and reflection of practitioners to achieve LISD's vision, mission, and goals.
- The Professional Learning Plan supports continual growth in alignment with the District Improvement Plan, individual campus priorities, and LEAD, reflecting a multi-year approach to develop staff in practice to impact student learning.
- The Professional Learning Plan is updated each year to address the focus of the district.
- The Professional Learning Plan is continuously updated to reflect the district's priorities, including the implementation of the new 3-year Long-Range Plan.
- SB 1267 requires the Board to annually review the State Board for Educator Clearinghouse regarding best practices and industry recommendations for professional development and adopt a professional development policy based on the training recommendations of the clearinghouse.
- These recommendations have been added to the District Professional Learning Plan.

Administrative Consideration:

- Approval of the District Professional Learning Plan. The District Professional Learning Plan reflects the recommended trainings as outlined in the clearinghouse, in addition to any training required by LISD.
